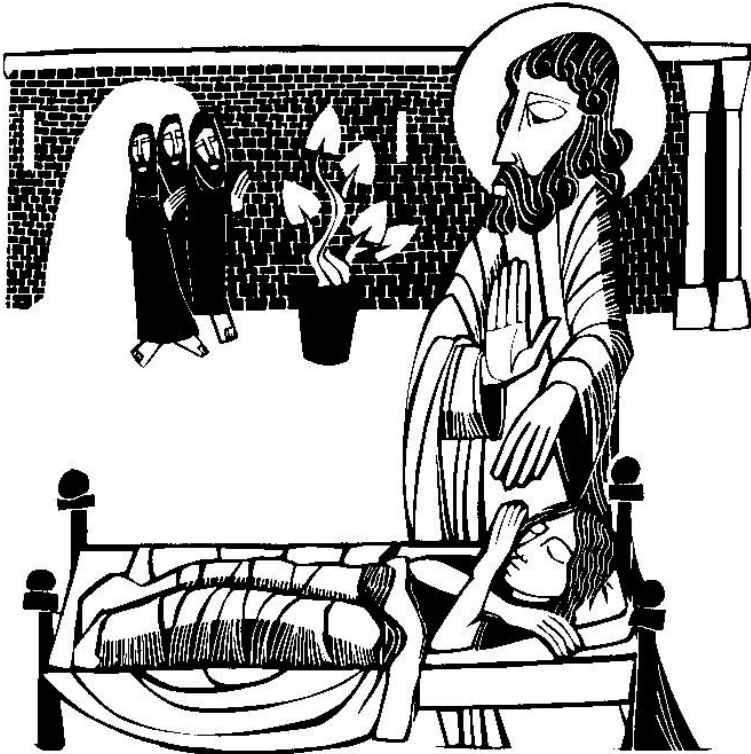


# Cathedral of St. Matthew the Apostle Washington, DC
