Anne Koester is an adjunct member of the Theology Department at Georgetown University, teaching courses in the areas of Catholic liturgy and worship as well as Christian initiation. She is a native of Ohio, where she attended Bowling Green State University (BS, Education) and the University of Toledo College of Law (Doctor of Jurisprudence). She practiced as a trial lawyer in Toledo for ten years, primarily in the areas of products liability and complex tort litigation, before deciding to pursue theology studies at St. John's University (MA, Theology), Collegeville, MN. She worked for two years at the University of Notre Dame and then moved to the DC area to accept the position of Associate Director of the Georgetown Center for Liturgy. In addition to teaching, she currently serves as Georgetown's Director of Off-Campus Student Life.
