VATICAN II: CELEBRATING 50 YEARS

Pope Benedict XVI has declared that a **Year of Faith** will begin October 11, 2012 and conclude November 24, 2013, the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, Universal King. The first day of the **Year of Faith** is the fiftieth anniversary of the opening of the Second Vatican Council. Our speaker on Wednesday is *Mr. H. Richard McCord, EdD*(retired director, Secretariat of Laity, Marriage, Family Life and Youth, United States Conference of Catholic Bishops; contributor, *Vatican II: The Continuing Agenda*)

H. Richard McCord holds a master's degree from Princeton Theological Seminary and a doctorate in education from the University of Maryland. He is the recipient of the Gaudium et Spes Award from the National Association for Lay Ministry in 2000 and the National Recognition Award from the National Association of Catholic Family Life Ministers in 1993. He has written extensively in Catholic periodicals and contributed chapters to *Vatican II: The Continuing Agenda, Families and Communities in Partnership, Using a Family Perspective*, and *Why We Serve*. He is married and the father of one child.

Our speaker on Thursday is *Ms. Sheila Garcia*

(associate director, Secretariat of Laity, Marriage, Family Life and Youth, United States Conference of Catholic Bishops)

Sheila Garcia has worked for the USCCB for the past 23 years. She has written and spoken on issues related to marriage and family, the laity, and women's leadership in the Church. Sheila holds a bachelor's degree in political science from Ohio University and a master's degree from De Sales School of Theology in Washington DC.
